2016–2017 is a defining season for Opera Columbus. This is a season featuring epic collaborations, innovative comedy, and historical artistic moments. We are so proud to open our season with BalletMet and the Columbus Symphony Orchestra in *Twisted 2*. What started as a risky venture in 2014 has grown into a Columbus staple in 2016. We have added new ideas and elements to expand this production of beautiful dancing and moving music. With over 120 artists on the Ohio Theatre stage, I know it will entertain and transport you, so hold on! We will then take a slight departure from previous programming with *Mission:* Seraglio, (Mozart's Abduction from the Seraglio); a crazy fun show based on James Bond, and then we will close our season with a new version of *Carmen* by Bizet. BalletMet2 joins us again for that production. This production is unique because the artistic team is made up of only women. For operaland, that is quite a feat! We have shrunk it to two hours and inserted the original dialogue.

2016–2017 will also mark season one of our collaboration with the Artist Diploma for Opera Studies (ADOS) program at The Juilliard School. We have truly begun fulfilling our mission to support and develop emerging talent. This is not only a great opportunity for the Juilliard ADOS artists, but also for Opera Columbus

audiences. Starting this season, our productions will feature exceptional Juilliard ADOS artists in principal roles, often making their role debuts here. OC will be part of their launching pad into what I believe will be world-renowned careers.

Opera on the Edge is back—this season we are producing two shows to introduce opera to everyone! You can find this season's shows of *The Magic Flute* and La Bohème at Shadowbox Live's Backstage Bistro, The Refectory Restaurant & Bistro, The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center, and even the mall! Cast with students from The Ohio State University and from our own local talent, this show will also travel throughout rural Ohio, and perform for over 10,000 students. It's affordable, lasts one hour, and it's in English. This is the perfect entry point for opera newcomers!

Opera Columbus and The Juilliard School


announce a special collaboration

pera Columbus is pleased to announce a new artistic collaboration with the Artist Diploma in Opera Studies (ADOS) program of the Marcus Institute for Vocal Arts at The Juilliard School. The ADOS program is an intensive, twoyear curriculum of advanced studies for highly gifted and experienced singers at the post-Master's level, selected through a comprehensive audition process. As part of the new collaboration, Opera Columbus Artistic Director Peggy Kriha Dye, herself a graduate of Juilliard, will observe the artists' development as they work through the ADOS program. Dye and ADOS director Stephen Wadsworth will determine what roles best suit each artist and what operas best suit upcoming Opera Columbus seasons. Selected ADOS artists will then be invited by Opera Columbus to perform in an upcoming main stage production, beginning with the 2016-2017 season.



"This new collaboration is a major celebration of Opera Columbus' mission to develop emerging talent, and will offer Columbus audiences the excitement of hearing these wonderful singers as their careers take off" said Opera Columbus Artistic Director Peggy Kriha Dye.

"The vocal division at Juilliard benefits from working closely with major opera companies here and abroad, but this is our first close connection to a regional U.S. company. Peggy's dynamic vision for the future of regional opera makes this agreement a dream scenario for the work we do at ADOS," said Juilliard's Director of ADOS Stephen Wadsworth. "Performances of leading roles in Opera Columbus productions will guarantee our singers real-world experience invaluable to their burgeoning careers."


